 - 6 (a) Fine increase from N2,500 to N500,000;
 - 7 (b) Fine increase from N250 to N300,000;
 - 8 (c) Fine increase from N25 to N200,000.
- 9 3. Section 392 of the Principal Act is amended by introducing the
10 new penalties: Amendment of
Section 392
 - 11 (a) Fine increase from N25 to N200,000.
- 12 4. This Bill may be cited as the Companies and Allied Matters Act
13 (Amendment) Bill, 2019. Citation
