ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-

- 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (in this Bill referred to as "the Alteration of the Principal Act") is altered as set out in this Bill.
- 2. Part 1 of the Fifth Schedule, to the Principal Act is altered –

Alteration of Fifth Schedule Part 1

- (a) in paragraph (2) (b), by -
 - (i) inserting after the word, "in", in line 4, the dash "—"; and
 - (ii) substituting for the word, "farming", in line 4, the expression –
 - "(a) agricultural production and services"
 - (b) healthcare education, production and services".
- 3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (Fifth Citation Alteration) Bill No. 26, 2022.

Explanatory Memorandum

This Bill seeks to alter the Fifth Schedule Part 1, to the Constitution Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 to permit public servants to engage in healthcare education, production and services beyond farming; and for related matters
